




War of the Ring Second Edition to be published in German, Italian and Spanish in spring 2012

After the English edition, releasing in 2011, Ares Games announces partnership agreements with Heidelberger, Red Glove and Devir for editions in the three languages



Camaione, Italy – November 08, 2011 – The long awaited new edition of War of the Ring board game is going to be released in English by the end of the month, and Ares Games has good news also to the non-English speaking players. The game is going to be published in three more languages next year, in cooperation with international partners: **Devir**, in Spain, **Heidelberger** Spieleverlag, in Germany, and **Red Glove**, in Italy. The Spanish, German and Italian editions will be released in Spring 2012.

Heidelberger, Red Glove and Devir will take care of the translation of the rulebook, cards and other game materials into their own languages, and will also handle the distribution of the local editions.
